When she awoke, he looked at her a bit puzzled. He then told her that he meant no good when she got into the car. "You know," he said, "when you curled up so trustingly and went to sleep I just couldn't touch you."

She points out this incident to emphasize that there is good in everybody and the only way to bring out the good

in people is to have faith and trust in them.

When she got out of the car and proceeded on her way, she turned back and there she saw the man, outside the car looking up into the sky as if to say that God must have come into his heart.

Peace Pilgrim has had her days with the law too. Some time ago she was investigated by the FBI and after spending 24 hours behind bars, she said that she was indifferent about leaving because there was work to do there. In every instance with the law she has been cleared and in each instance officials have told her that she seemed to glory in her experience.

Is her work producing dividends? She takes pride in saying that she started the petitions that brought about a peace department in the President's cabinet; that peace has come in Korea and now her goal is world disarmament.
