

'PEACE PILGRIM' 200,000 Miles

With a toothbrush in her pocket, a comb in her hair and a smile on her face, she walks . . . and walks . . . and walks.

She hasn't a penny in her pocket — and doesn't need one.

She walks until she is given shelter and fasts until she is given food.

Her name is - simply Peace Pilgrim. Her home "everywhere." And her message is "peace."

So far, she estimates, she has walked at least 200,000 miles in 20 years to deliver that message

Hard On Shoes

She's worn out 12 pairs of shoes and six of her unique uniforms since she first started walking "seriously" in January, 1953.

She walks 10,000 miles a year. She walks in rain, hail, heat, sleet and snow. She walks the year around through Mexico, the United States and Canada.
